

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Executed by the undersigned for the purpose of forming a Wisconsin Corporation under Chapter 181 of the Wisconsin Statutes, without stock and not for profit.

ARTICLE I.

The name shall be INDIANHEAD CURLING CLUB, Incorporated.

ARTICLE II.

The period of existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

The purpose of this organization shall be to provide facilities to encourage and promote the sport of curling in the City of Eau Claire and surrounding area.

ARTICLE IV.

The location of the principal office shall be 204 East Grand Avenue, Eau Claire, Wisconsin.

ARTICLE V.

ARTICLE VI.

The number of directors may be fixed by the by-laws but shall not be less than three.

ARTICLE VII.

The number of directors consisting of the initial board of directors shall be five.
